GENERAL AFFIDAVIT UNDER OATH OF ISABELLE ZEHNDER CONVERSATION WITH MAJESTIC RANCH STAFF AND FORMER STAFF

I, ISABELLE ZEHNDER, declare and state as follows:

- 1. I, ISABELLE ZEHNDER ("Declarant"), am a resident of the City of Battle Ground, County of Clark, State of Washington, and do hereby certify, swear or affirm, and declare that I am competent to give the following declaration based on my personal knowledge, unless otherwise stated, and that the following facts and things are true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
- 2. Former staff members of Majestic Ranch witnessed child abuse and neglect, lack of prompt and proper medical attention for the children, despicable living conditions for both children and staff, and more, and recently walked off their jobs due to what they witnessed during their employment there. It has taken great courage for some of these staff members to painfully recount the pain and suffering inflicted upon children they witnessed and were forced to participate in during their employment at Majestic Ranch and then to be willing to stand up against a giant corporation for the sake of the children. I commend them.
- 3. I interviewed some of those former staff members, summarized their testimony, put them into the proper affidavit format, provided it to them for their review, and once finalized, they signed them. Currently, the following affidavits have been completed. They are attached to my report and attached to this declaration as follows:

CONVERSATIONS WITH MICHELLE RILEY

4. I spoke to Michelle Riley, another former staff member who, to date, has not provided me with her affidavit. However, she has been willing to speak with me on several occasions and said she plans to provide me with her affidavit and evidence, including photos of AFFIDAVIT OF ISABELLE ZEHNDER RE CONVERSATIONS WITH MAJESTIC RANCH STAFF MEMBERS - 1

some of the children. Below is an account of those few, short conversations we had. She worked there for two years and I am sure she will have much more to tell.

- 5. I had a few short conversations with Michelle before my visit to CPS in Logan on February 7th. On that evening, after I had met with CPS earlier that day, I called Michelle and she told me she could not talk to me. She did not tell me why but I later learned from Martin, and then by her, that CPS worker Wanda Lundahl told them I had called the ranch 8 times on a Sunday impersonating a CPS worker, which is not true.
- 6. At the urging of another staff member I tried calling her again. Given she is the one with the truckload of evidence, as Wanda Lundahl said in her e-mail to me, I thought it was worth trying. She is now willing to talk to me again, realizing I did not call the ranch. As Martin indicated, no one even answers the phone on the weekends.
- 7. Michelle told me that Majestic Ranch recently sent her (1) an exit interview with a no-contact order, asking her to agree to no contact with anyone associated to Majestic Ranch for a period of one year; and (2) a staff conflict agreement contract (among other things, she would not be allowed to photocopy Majestic Ranch materials.) She said she has not signed or returned any of the documents.
- 8. Michelle indicated she received no formal training at Majestic Ranch. The only training she received, after she had been there two weeks, was from a woman named Gloria who had only herself been at Majestic Ranch for 8 weeks. Gloria was fired because it was discovered she had a felony record.
- 9. When I asked Michelle about the Mandt System for restraints, she said they do not do proper Mandt System restraints.
- 10. One of the boys was dropped to a level 1 when he received a Cat 4 consequence. She tried to share her concerns with Wayne because she felt this was unfair and unwarranted. Wayne told her it would be more money in their pockets and did nothing to support this child.
- 11. When some staff members wanted to sleep in rather than get up with the children they made the children stand between flag poles.
